Rationale: Current trends in enrollment and transfer indicate that many of our HSW program students complete all coursework for the program with the exception of the HSW 230 Internship class. Students who currently work in the field or have extensive volunteer experience are able to move into a BSW program without completing the HSW 230 class, hence not completing our AAHUST degree. Offering students actively working/volunteering in the field of helping an alternative path to graduation will likely increase our program completion rates. A program change will be submitted for Fall 2022.

Proposed Start Semester: Winter 2022

Course Description: In this course, students will explore workplace dynamics through various theoretical lenses. They will apply core theoretical frameworks, such as system theory, behavioral/social learning theory, psychodynamic theory and developmental theory. Students will be required to write a 3-5 page APA style research paper demonstrating their understanding of theory as applied to their current helping role. This course is reserved for students who are actively participating in a job (paid or unpaid) that is part of a helping profession.
