Registered Nursing (APNURS)

WCC is no longer collecting applications to the Registered Nursing program for the Winter 2026 semester. The application packet for the <u>Fall 2026</u> semester is expected to become available in <u>mid-November 2025</u> with an expected application deadline in <u>late January 2026</u>.

To be eligible to apply for the next admission cycle, all admission requirements must be successfully completed by the application deadline. If you have not yet applied to WCC, please submit an <u>admission application</u> to the school. You must be admitted to the school <u>before</u> you will be eligible to apply to the Nursing program or schedule an appointment with an academic advisor.

This video is available on our website and is <u>required</u> by all applicants prior to applying the program. Program requirements are specific and we recommend meeting with a Health Program Advisor regularly to help lay out a plan for meeting admission requirements, making class selections, and to discuss ways to make your application competitive.
